


El Papyrus de ANI

El Papyrus de Ani es un manuscrito en papiro escrito en jeroglíficos cursivos e ilustrado con miniaturas de color creados en la Dinastía XIX del Imperio Nuevo del Antiguo Egipto (c. 1250 a C). Los egipcios compilaban un libro individualizado para cada difunto llamado el “Libro de Salir al Día”, comúnmente conocido como “el Libro de los Muertos”. Contiene las declaraciones y hechizos que lo ayudarán en su vida de Ultratumba.

El “Libro de los Muertos” de Ani, Escribe y Tesorero de los Templos de Egipto , Tebas , es el manuscrito llamado el Papyrus de Ani.

Fue comprado en 1888 por Sir E.A. Wallis Budge para el Museo Británico.


Antes de enviar el manuscrito a Inglaterra, Budge corta el rollo de papiro de setenta y ocho pies en treinta y siete fragmentos de tamaño casi igual, dañando la integridad del rollo con una tecnología que no ha permitido volver a unirlos.



































